Pernilla Dahm Kähler

Associate professor Pernilla Dahm Kähler graduated from University of Gothenburg in 1990 and became a specialist in Obstetrics and Gynecology in 1999. She started, as the first in Sweden, a subspecialty program in Gyne-Oncology surgery and became certified in 2005 and finished her PhD in 2006. Since 2009 she is the Head of the Gyne-Oncology surgery division at the department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Sahlgrenska University Hospital in Gothenburg, Sweden. She has been working intensively with optimizing gynaecological cancer surgery including robotic surgery and centralization of advanced surgery.

Pernilla Dahm Kähler is board member of multiple national expert referral groups including the Swedish Quality Register for Gynecological Cancer and has been involved in the successful Uterus Transplantation (UTx) project in Gothenburg since the start in 2000. She is a senior key member of the successful team resulting in the world's first healthy babies after UTx, including birth after robotic uterus retrieval. Furthermore, she is working with the international registry for UTx.

Surgical training methods are essential to acknowledge, in particular concerning innovative surgical methods such as robotics. In order to ensure patients' safety in newly developed surgical procedures such as UTx it is of great importance to Pernilla Dahm Kähler to be part of a discussion and process towards scientifically validated robotic training methods.
